

# Cleaning Procedures



- All classrooms will have hand sanitizer.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces with Clorox wipes and Lysol Disinfectant Spray using rubber gloves throughout the use of each class.
- Each classroom will be disinfected before, between, and after each service using rubber gloves (This will include door handles, classroom and hallway restrooms, tables, chairs, counters, all toys, rocking chairs, changing tables, etc.)
- Volunteers will wash hands often with soap and water.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Snacks will not be served.

For the protection of all children and volunteers, neither children nor volunteers with any of the following symptoms should be in a classroom:

- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Untreated pink eye or another eye infection
- Symptoms of childhood diseases, like chicken pox, fifth disease, hand foot and mouth disease, etc.
- Sore throat
- Croup
- Common cold, including colored runny nose
- Lice, including the presence of eggs or nits

An ill child may not stay in the classroom, so if a Ridge Kids volunteer suspects that a child is sick, they will contact the child's parents. Ridge Kids wants everyone to have a great worship experience!
