Potty Training Information

For SonShine Preschool, it is not an enrollment requirement that children be potty trained by age 3. However, we find that most children are either successfully trained or in the process by the time they enter our 3-year-old program each fall. We also fully understand that both emotional and physical readiness to potty train is unique to each child and there is no set timeline or specific age when a child should be ready.

We do encourage parents to actively work on potty training over the summer months before school year begins. If your child is not fully potty trained by August 8, we ask that you notify our office (sonshinepreschool@daustinridge.org).

On "Meet the Teacher" day, we also ask you share with your child's teacher what method & words you use at home so she can be consistent and reinforce during the school day. Consistency at home and school makes a huge difference in the child's potty training success!

If your child is not completely potty trained, we ask that you bring labeled diapers/pull ups to school.
