PASSAGE: ACTS 17: 1-15

SERMON DATE: September 8, 2024

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Today, we are flooded with new information and ideas through social media, news, and many other forms of content. What is your approach to testing these new ideas, teachings, and cultural trends against Scripture?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. Paul reasoned with the Jews for three Sabbaths. How can you use scripture to share your faith with those around you? Are you confident in sharing your faith, or is that an area where you need to grow?
2. In verse 6 the accusers said, "These men have turned the world upside down." How can you live out your faith in a way that impacts your community, even if it challenges the status quo?
3. The Bereans received the message with eagerness. Do you approach God's word eagerly, or does it sometimes feel like an obligation? How can you cultivate a heart that is more passionate about God's word?
4. Paul's companions helped him continue his journey. Who are the people in your life who support and encourage you in your relationship with Jesus? How can you support others in their relationship with Jesus?

PRAY

1. Pray for an open heart like the Bereans, who eagerly examine scripture daily. Ask God to help you approach the Word with that same desire to learn.
2. Pray for missionaries around the world who are spreading God's word. Pray for protection, wisdom, and for people to have receptive hearts.
3. Pray for perseverance like Paul and Silas. Pray for resilience when you face resistance in your walk with Christ.
