

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: ACTS 20:13-38

SERMON DATE: Nov 10, 2024

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

How do you say goodbye when you have to leave those you love? Is it short and sweet, long and drawn out, or do you act like it is no big deal?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. Paul was humble, endured trials, and stayed focused on Jesus and the ministry He had given him (Acts 20:19-23). How do we remain focused on Jesus even during trials and suffering? What ministry has Jesus given to you?
2. You may not be in leadership at the church, but we are all called to pay careful attention to ourselves and how we live (Acts 20:28). How can we stay mindful of our actions so that we walk humbly with God and care for our brothers and sisters in Christ?
3. Paul tells the Ephesian elders to remember that giving is better than receiving (Acts 20:35). How can we live generous lives, giving our time, talent, and treasure to bless others and build the Kingdom of God?

PRAY

1. Ask God to give us a singular focus on walking with Jesus daily and pursuing the ministry He has given us.
2. Ask God to increase our generosity and open our eyes to the best way to use our time, talent, and treasure to build God's Kingdom instead of creating our little kingdoms.
