PASSAGE: I Missions Sunday, Luke 15:1-3

## CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What are some things that stood out or surprised you in this week's message?

## GROW

Have someone read Luke 15:1-3 out loud.

What stood out to you in the passage?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

## GO

1. Where are you more like the Pharisees than you care to admit?
2. If we are to model Jesus's example, how should we respond not just to the lost but to the outcasts and vulnerable?
3. What are some practical steps you can take?
4. Are there specific vulnerable populations that you would have difficulty engaging? How can you work to change that?

## PRAY

1. Pray to have God's heart for the vulnerable around you.
2. Ask Him to give you compassion for those you naturally avoid, dismiss, or write off.
3. Pray for courage to take one concrete step toward someone who feels lost, excluded, or unseen.
