

# SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Philippians 2:19-30  
SERMON DATE: February 22, 2026

## CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Share about a time when you had to take a risk or make a sacrifice to help someone else. What did you learn from the experience?

## GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

## GO

1. Paul highlights Timothy's genuine concern for others' welfare. Who in your life models that kind of selfless care, and how can you follow their example?
2. Paul contrasts Timothy's attitude with that of those who "seek their own interests." In what areas do you find it hardest to put others first, and what's one way you can grow in this?
3. Both Timothy and Epaphroditus were willing to go wherever God wanted them to go for the sake of the gospel. How open are you to stepping out of your comfort zone to serve God or others?
4. How do you respond when you're misunderstood, overlooked, or when your efforts go unnoticed? What does this passage teach about serving humbly and faithfully, regardless of recognition?

## PRAY

1. Ask God to give you a heart like Timothy's—genuinely concerned for the needs and well-being of others. Pray for eyes to see opportunities to serve and encourage people around you.
2. Pray for courage to step outside your comfort zone, like Epaphroditus, and to say "yes" when God calls you to serve in challenging or unfamiliar ways.
3. Pray for open doors to encourage someone specific this week—maybe with a call, a text message, or a practical act of kindness. Ask God to use your words and actions to strengthen their faith and joy.
