

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Revelation 1:1-8

SERMON DATE: March 2, 2025

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What excites you about the book of Revelation? Have you ever read or studied it yourself?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. Verse 5 reminds us that Jesus “loves us” and has “freed us from our sins by His blood.” How does this truth impact your identity in Christ? How can this help you fight temptation? How can it impact the way you share the gospel with others?
2. Verse 7 promises that Jesus is coming again. Is that something you ever think about? Do you feel your life, decisions, and priorities reflect a belief in that? What's one area you can think of that would change if you really believed the truth of that statement?
3. Verse 8 says that God is “the one who is and who was and who is to come,” meaning that He is eternal, outside of time, and not caught off guard by our circumstances. How does this help you trust Him during uncertainty or a trial? How could this truth encourage someone else going through something?

PRAY

1. Thank the Lord for the love and forgiveness we receive by grace through faith in Him.
2. Ask for a sense of urgency to live in light of the truth that Jesus is coming again.
3. Ask for wisdom and discernment as we study Revelation together.
