

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Revelation 10

SERMON DATE: July 6, 2025

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Can you share a time when something started sweet but became unexpectedly difficult?
How did God meet you at that time?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. We don't know what the seven thunders said in verses 3-4. God often reveals what we need to know, but not everything we want to know. How do we navigate the mysteries and unanswered questions of our faith journey?
2. What does it look like in your life to "eat the scroll" and fully embrace God's Word, even when it brings both joy and comfort as well as conviction and the need for repentance?
3. Revelation 10:11 says that John will prophesy again about many peoples, nations, languages, and kings. Are there areas where we feel called to speak the truth, even when it may be uncomfortable or costly? How can we speak the truth in love?

PRAY

1. Tell God that we don't always understand your timing and ways, but we trust that you are sovereign and in control. Teach us to trust you when we don't know what is happening and to wait for you and walk by faith patiently.
2. Pray that the Lord will help us receive His word with open hearts, not just when it is sweet, but even when it challenges us. Please give us the strength to live it out with boldness and faith.
